Unaccepted Items

Do Not Bring - Motor oil, antifreeze, automobile batteries or other lead batteries, propane tanks or oil-based space heaters, they will not be accepted.

- Motor oil, antifreeze, and lead batteries are accepted for free at the County Landfill Recycling Center, 21101 Evergreen Mills Road, Leesburg, VA 20175, www.loudoun.gov/landfill.
- Propane tanks and oil-based space heaters are accepted at the County Landfill, fee applies.

Do Not Bring - Electronics, ammunition, medical waste, or medications, they will not be accepted.

Do Not Bring - Latex paint or water-based paint to the HHW events. These types of paint are not hazardous and are accepted at the landfill year-round, fee applies.
